Biological Waste ^T (incl. infectious animal bedding/carcasses)	Stericycle Box/Bag unit	Contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115 for proper disposal procedures.
Medical Waste ^T ; All needles, syringes, scalpels, blades & Medical Waste	Sharps Container with UConn Address Label; Box/Bag Unit	Contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115 for proper disposal procedures.

Mercury Containing Lamps ^T ; Linear Fluorescent, HID / HPS , U & Circlelines, Biax & Compact / PL's	Boxed, Taped & Labeled as Universal Waste with Accum. Start Date.	Contact Branch Facility Director. The Facility Director will recycle or contract local recycling company for disposal.
Batteries, Automotive ^T : (Lead/acid vehicle batteries)	Cover Terminals & Label as Universal Waste with Accum. Start Date	Chemical waste pickup requests can be made online www.ehs.uconn.edu or contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115.
Batteries, Non-Automotive ^T : (Lead/acid, Ni/Cd, Silver Oxide, Lithium, mercury, magnesium)	Cover Terminals & Label as Universal Waste with Accum. Start Date	Chemical waste pickup requests can be made online www.ehs.uconn.edu or contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115.
Mercury Thermostats ^T	Containerize & Label as Universal Waste with Accum. Start Date	Chemical waste pickup requests can be made online www.ehs.uconn.edu or contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115.
Used Electronic Equipment ^T ; Computers, Monitors, VCRs, Radios, Copiers, etc	Complete a form ACT-39. Contact Central Stores for a pickup request.	Contact UConn Surplus (860) 486-3094. Central Stores will collect, resell or contract an e-waste recycler to remove this material.
Facility Waste Types*	Container** & Label	Contact and Final Disposal
Antifreeze (ethylene glycol)	Store in an appropriate container and label as "Used Antifreeze"	Chemical waste pickup requests can be made online www.ehs.uconn.edu or contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115.
Asbestos ^T containing material or suspected asbestos containing material	DO NOT remove asbestos. Must be removed by a licensed abatement contractor.	Contact Facilities Work Order Control at (860) 486-3113. An asbestos abatement company will be contracted to conduct the removal.
Freon/Refrigerant Gas-containing Equipment ^T (refrigerators, air conditioners)	Have Facilities remove all CFCs from the Equipment & Label as empty	Contact Branch Facility Director. The Facility Director will recycle or contract local recycling company for disposal.
Petroleum Products ^T (used oil, fuel filters, oily/fuel soaked rags)	Contact EH&S for proper labeling.	Chemical waste pickup requests can be made online www.ehs.uconn.edu or contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115.
Aerosol cans (full or empty)	Use red & white Hazardous Waste Labels from EH&S	Chemical waste pickup requests can be made online www.ehs.uconn.edu or contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115.
Oil Containing Equipment	Have Facilities remove all oil from the Equipment & Label	Dispose of oil as Petroleum Products
Solvent or Oil Containing Rags	Contact EH&S for proper labeling.	Chemical waste pickup requests can be made online www.ehs.uconn.edu or contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115.
Fluorescent Lamp Ballasts ^T	Use ballast information to make a hazard determination	Chemical waste pickup requests can be made online www.ehs.uconn.edu or contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115.
Paint (Latex and Solvent Based) ^T	Keep in original containers and label as Hazardous Waste.	Chemical waste pickup requests can be made online www.ehs.uconn.edu or contact Denis Shannon (860) 486-3115.
Other Waste Types	Container & Label	Contact and Final Disposal
Radioactive Material ^T	Supplied by UConn EH&S Radiation Safety Section	Contact Roy Brown - EH&S (860) 486-0925.
Kitchen Grease (used kitchen oils and grease)	Contact local waste company for a grease dumpster.	Kitchens run by private companies are required to properly dispose of kitchen waste on their own.

** All containers used **MUST** be compatible with the type of waste stored in them.
